- All programs are free to participants
- Provide current information about mental health conditions & treatment options
- Programs are peer-led; Leaders speak from the perspective of an equal
- Leaders complete intensive training to receive certification
- Built around standardized manuals; information is presented accurately and in a structured way; Trauma approach learning
- Inspire hope through shared stories of recovery and resiliency

Training Program Leaders

Role of NSO is to provide Leader training within their state and to ensure that NAs are receiving quality training from certified NAMI State Trainers.



Virtual | June 11 – 13

- NSO is responsible for providing Leader Training and will vet final candidates, secure trainers, provide supplies, data collection, etc.
- NSO may grant NA permission to host Leader Training within their state. NSO and NA will collaborate to ensure that candidates are vetted, certified trainers are secured, data recorded, etc. NSO should define the roles prior to a training.
- Out of State Leader Training: While individuals may attend Leader training hosted by a state other than their own, it is the role of the NSO to approve the training prior to attending.
- States may collaborate to hold Leader Trainings.
- Never contact a State Trainer directly, always go through the State
 Org to secure a qualified state trainer and to ensure you are not
 taking away a trainer that state may need.

- All program translations/transcreation are the responsibility of NAMI National
- National will work with field leaders to determine need
- National will also work with field leaders to create accessible programming
- National welcomes all requests, suggestions, conversations, and sharing of information
